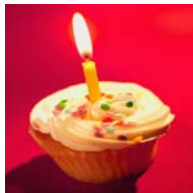

## Recipe of the Month

Baked Triple Veggie Dip

Prep Time: 15 min    Cooking Time: 35 min - Total time in Kitchen 50 min

1 can (1lb 3oz) asparagus spears, drained and chopped  
 1 pkg (10oz) frozen chopped spinach, thawed, drained well  
 1 can (8 1/2 oz) artichoke hearts, drained, chopped  
 1 container (8 oz) Philadelphia Chive & Onion or Garden Vegetable Cream Cheese Spread  
 1/2 cup Regular Mayonnaise  
 1 1/2 cup 100% Parmesan Cheese, reserve 1/4 cup for topping

Preheat oven to 375. Mix all ingredients, reserving 1/4 cup Parmesan cheese. Spoon into 2 qt baking dish. Sprinkle with reserved cheese. Bake 35 min. or until lightly browned. Serve hot with Triscuit Thin Crisps and assorted cut up vegetables. makes 4 1/2 cups.
